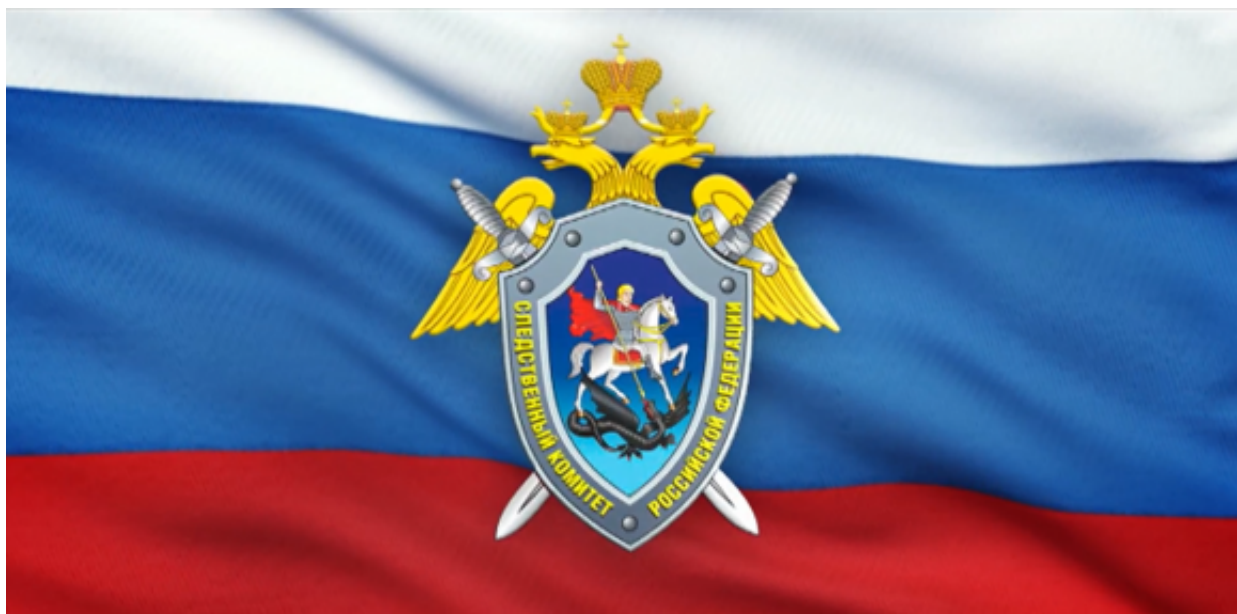

Investigative Committee hosts reporting back meeting of NGO Union of Investigation Veterans



Today the Russia's Investigative Committee hosted a reporting back meeting of the Regional NGO Union of Investigation Veterans dedicated to the organization's performance in 2015 and discussion of current issues. The event was attended by the Chairman of the Investigative Committee and representatives of regional offices of the organization.
