
Investigative Committee sets up board of trustees for Alexander Nevsky Cadet School



Alexander Bastrykin, Chairman of the Russia's Investigative Committee, held the first meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Alexander Nevsky Cadet School of the Investigative Committee. The meeting elected management bodies of the Board, honorary chairman of which was elected the People's Artist of the USSR Vasily Lanovoi, while Dmitry Sablin, a member of Federation Council Defense and Security Committee was named as his vice-chairman.
