
Cadets of Alexander Nevsky Cadet School of Investigative Committee take part in cadet parade “May not Break the Connection between generations”



On 6 May 2016, cadets of the Alexander Nevsky Cadet School of the Investigative Committee took part in the Cadet Parade on Poklonnaya Mountain in Moscow held under the slogan “May not break the connection between generations”.

Among guests of honor attending the parade were Patriarch of Moscow and Russia Cyril, Moscow Mayor Sergei Sobyenin, veterans of the Great Patriotic War, Director of the Alexander Nevsky Cadet School of the Investigative Committee Igor Zaporozhan and heads of other cadet schools.
