On 1 June 2015, the International Children's Day, officials of the Central Office of the Investigative Committee visited the Murom Infant Home (specialized) in Vladimir Region again.

The staff of the investigative authorities if necessary take measures to organize provision of highly-qualified medical aid to seriously-ill inmates of the facilities, as well as to assist with education and adjustment of orphans after they leave facilities.
