
Alexander Bastrykin goes to Stavropol Territory for working visit



Chairman of the RF Investigative Committee Alexander Bastrykin has today visited the Lieutenant General of Justice Mikhail Yarov school No 24 in the city of Stavropol to open the cadet swearing-in ceremony for the 8th cadet class of the Investigative Committee.

The ceremony was attended by Vice Chairmen of the Investigative Committee Boris Karnaukhov and Ilya Lazutov, heads of investigative offices for constituent territories of North Caucasian Federal District, veterans of investigation profession and representatives of authorities and the public.

Mr. Bastrykin said that from childhood the life of each of the Russian people is associated with serving to the Fatherland and loyalty to it.
