Investigative Committee Chairman and Artistic Director of Mariinsky Theater Valery Gergiyev sign cooperation agreement



Chairman of the Investigative Committee Alexander Bastrykin and artistic director of the Mariinsky Theater, People's Artist of the Russian Federation Valery Gergiyev have signed today an agreement on cooperation between the agency and the theater.
