
Alexander Bastrykin holds briefing in Tula



Chairman of the Investigative Committee has held today a briefing in the city of Tula attended by senior officials of Investigative Committee's offices located in Central Federal District, as well as by heads of the first department of the Investigative Committee's Head Office and Moscow Interregional Transport Office.


Mr. Bastrykin heard reports on the progress and results of investigations into most complicated and high profile cases the investigative authorities located in Central Federal District are dealing with.
