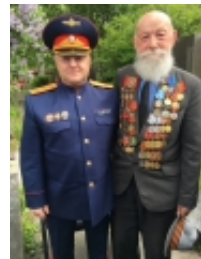
On the 120th birthday of General Batov they laid flowers to his grave and rendered military honors.
