The Chairman assured that officers of the Investigative Committee of Russia will continue providing regular help to the institution and instructed the direction of the Saint Petersburg Academy to provide legal assistance to the residents of the children's centre and suggested organising for them joint sports sections and sports events with the students of the Academy on the basis of the Investigative Committee educational institution that has a swimming pool, a gym and other necessary equipment for high-quality leisure for the children.

Alexander Bastrykin underlined that it was necessary to do everything possible for social adaptation of the residents of the children's centre and added that it was very important for each child to feel the warmth and love of adults, despite everything.
