The chairman of Russia's Investigative Committee has instructed to check and report on citizens' concerns related to the construction of a settlement in the village of Nechosovo, Moscow Region



The media reported on the planned construction of an "eco-settlement" Aminovka in the village of Nechesovo in the Shakhovsky district, Moscow region. There were concerns in the media that a religious enclave was being planned for the area and that nearby residents had already received some kind of threat. One publication also suggested that the settlement was being set up as a religious sect.

The Chairman of the Investigative Committee of Russia instructed the head of the Moscow Regional Investigative Department of the Investigative Committee of Russia Starikov A.Yu. to clarify all the circumstances, check the arguments presented in the media and submit a detailed report on the situation.
