
The Chairman of the Investigative Committee of Russia requests a report on the progress of assessment into non-payment of wages to employees of a Sevastopol organization



In connection with the published intention of the employees of the contracting company "Center" of the private company "Mir" in Sevastopol, who reportedly have not been paid their salaries since August this year, to appeal to the leadership of the Investigative Committee of Russia, Alexander Ivanovich Bastrykin instructed to report on the measures taken by the investigation aimed at restoring the violated rights of citizens.
