

The Chairman of the Investigative Committee Takes Part in a Meeting of the Board of the Ministry of Emergency Situations of Russia Summarizing the 2021 Performance



Alexander Ivanovich Bastrykin, the Chairman of the Investigative Committee of the Russian Federation, took part in a video conference meeting of the board of the Ministry of Emergency Situations of Russia, which summed up the 2021 performance of the Ministry and set the 2022 priority areas.

Vladimir Vladimirovich Putin, the President of the Russian Federation, spoke at the board meeting and noted that over the past three decades the Ministry had become a well-coordinated, mobile, well-equipped organization responsible for protecting our citizens from emergencies, for fires prevention and extinguishing, for the civil defense system development.
