Today citizens from the Moscow, Vladimir and Nizhny Novgorod regions, Komi republic, Jewish Autonomous Region and Moscow city called the Chairman of the Russian Federation Investigative Committee on the phones 8 800-333-02-95 and 8-495-640-20-46.

The citizens mostly complained about improper investigation of criminal cases by territorial investigating bodies of the Investigative Committee and expressed their disagreement with procedural decisions in criminal cases.

Following the communication Alexander Bastrykin gave explicit instructions to the heads of a number of territorial investigating bodies of the Investigative Committee.
