
Research and development conference: “Russia in Patriotic War of 1812” takes place in Alexander Nevsky Cadet School of the Russia’s Investigative Committee



A student research and development conference: “Russia in Patriotic War of 1812” has taken place today, on 200th anniversary of the day when the last soldier of French Napoleon’s army left Russia, in Alexander Nevsky Cadet School of the Russia’s Investigative Committee.

The conference was attended by Cavalier of Alexander Nevsky Order, participant of Great Patriotic War Kirill Konstantinovich Berends, PhD of law, member of Academy of Military Sciences, Chairman of law thesis committee of the Military University of the Russian Ministry of Defense Sergey Vladimirovich Malikov, and Alexander Sergeyevich Shurinov – a descendant of a participant of Patriotic War of 1812, awarded Gold sword for the battle of Borodino.

The reports covered different subjects including activity of preliminary investigation bodies and system of law enforcement during Patriotic War of 1812.

Results were summed up the festival “Threat of 1812” and winners were awarded at the conference.
