

Staff of Udmurtia Investigations Directorate of Russia's Investigative Committee took part in Victory Day celebrations



On the morning of May 9, the laying of flowers and garlands of Glory at the Eternal Flame began. Hundreds of residents of Izhevsk, including top officials of the republic, took part in it. Flowers were laid at the monument of military and labor glory. Carnations, chrysanthemums, daffodils and tulips decorated a pedestal at the feet of the Unknown Soldier.

The celebratory events were attended by the head of the Udmurt Republic Investigations Directorate of the Investigative Committee of the Russian Federation Lieutenant-General Vladimir Nikeshekin.
