Pyotr Vasilyevich Prunitsa dedicated the rest of his life to serving his motherland – he became a professional soldier (served in the engineer troops). Employees of the Investigations

Directorate thanked the veteran for the victory, and observed a minute of silence in commemoration of the war dead.

At the end of the solemn ceremony, the Head of the Khabarovsk Territory Investigations Directorate of the Investigative Committee of the Russian Federation Kirill Levit presented awards to the best employees, under the leadership of who complicated and intricate crimes had been solved.
