
Alexander Bastrykin holds meeting discussing fighting rights of people in South East of Ukraine



Chairman of the Russia's Investigative Committee Alexander Bastrykin held a meeting on 3 September 2015 to discuss fighting violation of rights of civilians in the south east of Ukraine during an armed conflict.

Results of work of the Department for investigating crimes connected with use of forbidden means and methods of warfare of the Main Investigations Directorate were heard during the meeting.
