
Russia's Investigative Committee Chairman pays working visit to Azerbaijan



Today Chairman of the Russia's Investigative Committee Alexander Bastrykin paid a working visit to Azerbaijan. During planned events a cooperation agreement was signed between the Russia's Investigative Committee and Azerbaijan's Prosecutor General's Office. The signing of such an agreement will contribute to development of cooperation with law-enforcement authorities of Azerbaijan and will help to bring cooperation between the two agencies to the new level of strategic partnership.
